## MISHAP NOTIFICATION AND REPORTING

This instruction establishes local Mishap Reporting Procedures as required by CAPR 62-1.

1. Local Mishap Reporting: The squadron Commander must be notified <u>immediately</u> in the event of any Mishap, Close Call/Near Miss or Safety Deviation involving squadron personnel or equipment. Call the following individuals <u>IN THE</u> ORDER LISTED, until one person is reached. The first person contacted will notify the remainder of the local list.

2. CAWG Mishap Reporting: Call the following individuals <u>IN THE ORDER LISTED</u>, until one person is reached. The first person contacted will notify the remainder of the CAWG list.

3. Group Mishap Reporting: Call the following individuals IN THE ORDER LISTED, until one person is reached. The first person contacted will notify the remainder of the Group list.

Note: The above notifications are to be made <u>ONLY</u> in person or by telephone. Do not use the radio or other means, as it may seriously compromise subsequent activities.

## 4. File Mishap Report:

In cases of serious injury or death: The unit/activity commander must <u>immediately</u> contact the CAP\_National Operations Center (NOC) toll free at 1-888-211-1812, Ext 300. Coordinate with the CAP General Council <u>prior</u> to completing the online Initial Mishap Notification (Step 1).

In cases <u>not</u> involving serious injury or death: <u>AFTER</u> making contact with the personnel listed above, FILE NEW MISHAP (1) should be completed <u>as soon as possible</u> to notify appropriate personnel. The eServices Initial Mishap Notification (Step 1) is located in the Safety Management System (SMS). Instructions for completing the Initial Notification are included in the Online Safety Education module in SMS. UPDATE NEW MISHAP (2) can be completed at the same time if all relevant information is available or at a later time, however Step 2 <u>SHALL</u> be completed within 48 hours of the mishap occurrence. The Mishap Report Worksheet located under "References" on the SMS main page should be printed and used to gather information prior to online data input.
